

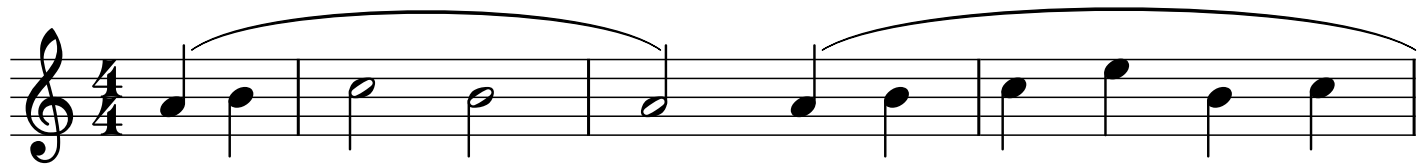

Known by a multitude of names including:

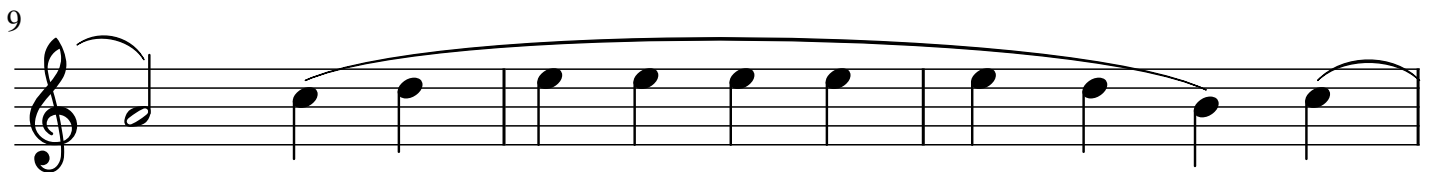
"The Snake Charmer", "The Streets of Cairo", and "The Southern Part of France"



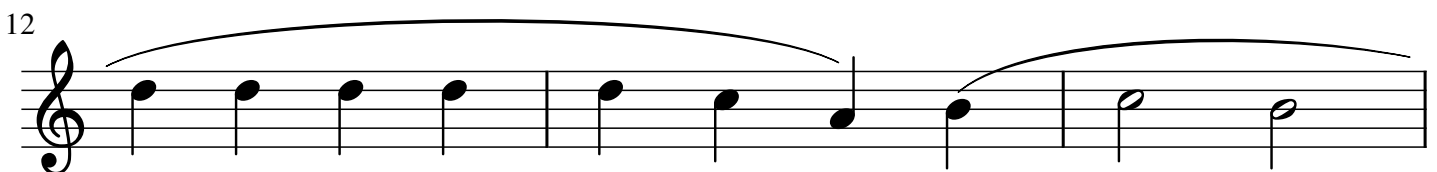

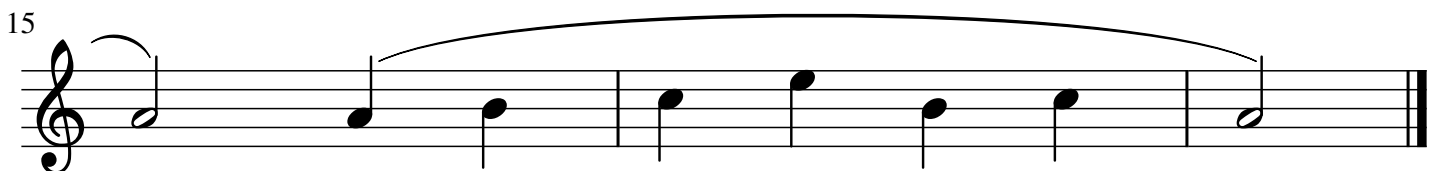
